Our focus on advancing women in science and technology sectors also aligns with fostering innovation and building resilient infrastructure.



REGIONAL "STARTECH" PROGRAM



The regional program has been running since 2016, and thanks to the StarTech initiative, **nearly a thousand girls** from rural areas, **including small villages**, have been granted the opportunity to immerse themselves in the world of technology and explore its potential.



The ultimate goal of holding these events is to attract Azerbaijani girls from the regions to the field of information and communication technologies and to increase involvement percentage. **Events are conducted on a charitable purpose.**



The program was carried out in locations like Masally, Gabala, Guba, Shamakhi, Mingachevir, Lankaran, Ismayilli, and Sheki where it received positive feedback from both the girls and their parents.



It is important to underscore that this program plays a significant role in expanding the horizons for schoolgirls aiming for professional and higher education in the technology field.

A seminar on **honing presentation skills** was conducted. Upon its conclusion, the girls within the teams, presented innovative projects and implementation plan to the audience. Each girl had to select a profession and role within their respective projects.



During a practical session, mentors from STEP IT Academy acquainted the girls with **coding and robotics basics**.

RESEARCH PAPER



"FEMMES DIGITALES" presents its research on the best practices and achievements of leading IT companies of Azerbaijan in retaining women employees in the IT industry.

The comprehensive study focuses on three key areas:

Company policies on retaining women employees, Evidence-based support for women in TECH, The role of top management in fostering a supportive environment

The research explores approaches used by leading companies and organizations such as A2Z Technologies, Digital Umbrella, MONT, and Fominov Consulting to address challenges faced by women in the field, including gender stereotypes.

It analyzes company policies for retaining women employees, such as creating inclusive environments and promoting equality. Successful strategies include flexible work arrangements, skill development, and advocating for equal pay based on skills and experience. The study also showcases evidence-based support for women in tech, including mentorship programs, networking opportunities, and training support.












AWARENESS CAMPAIGN IN SOCIAL MEDIA
