

Program Brief



Firstly, representatives of "FEMMES DIGITALES" introduced various TECH-related careers by sharing their experiences, and demonstrating their professional skills.



The schoolgirls were provided with a list of universities in Azerbaijan where they could pursue further education in TECH.



In the seminar "Adventures in the World of Artificial Intelligence" the girls discovered the possibilities of AI and its application to the modern world, including working with such advanced tools as ChatGPT.



During a practical session, mentors from STEP IT Academy acquainted the girls with coding and robotics basics.



















"STARTECH" REGIONAL PROGRAM



The regional program has been running since 2016, and thanks to the StarTech initiative, **nearly a thousand girls** from rural areas, **including small villages**, have been granted the opportunity to immerse themselves in the world of technology and explore its potential.



The ultimate goal of holding these events is to attract Azerbaijani girls from the regions to the field of information and communication technologies and to increase involvement percentage. **Events are conducted on a charitable purpose.**



The program was carried out in locations like Masally, Gabala, Guba, Shamakhi, Mingachevir, Lankaran, Ismayilli, Sheki, and Nakchivan where it received positive feedback from both the girls and their parents.



It is important to underscore that this program plays a significant role in expanding the horizons for schoolgirls aiming for professional and higher education in the technology field.



REPRESENTATION ON IDD GLOBAL STAGE

Sayyara Huseynova and **Khayala Fatullayeva** represented Azerbaijan at the "Investing for Gender Equality and Inclusive Climate Action" dialogue during the International Development Days (IDD2024) in Istanbul. Organized by UNDP and OECD, the event took place on October 17-18, 2024, bringing together global leaders to discuss the critical intersection of gender equality and climate action.

On October 16th, preceding the dialogue, **Sayyara** spoke at the UNDP Eurasia Regional Gender Specialists Meeting, highlighting FEMMES DIGITALES' 10-year journey in empowering girls from vulnerable regions of Azerbaijan and promoting leadership in the TECH sector.






COLLABORATION OPPORTUNITIES



On March 18, an educational information session was held for schoolgirls in collaboration with the Tartar Women's Resource Center. The online "Equal Opportunities and Rights for the Participation of Women and Girls in Technology" event was attended by 70 secondary school girls from Agjabadi, Barda, and Tartar who are interested in ICT fields. uring this session, which was attended by numerous school and college students, representatives from our Public Union-Shahla Mammadova, Safiya Aghamirova, Ulduza Khalilova, as well as Shalala Hamzayeva – discussed career opportunities in the IT field. Schoolgirls explored accessible and free course platforms for programming and other technical areas, as well as shared stories of successful women in this sector. The schoolgirls were provided with information about different occupations in the TECH sphere, the knowledge and skills needed to pursue these professions, and user experiences.



On March 27th, Secretary General Sayyara Huseynova, and Executive Board Member Shahla Mammadova had the privilege of meeting with His Excellency Tobias Lorentzson, the Swedish Ambassador to Azerbaijan, along with Sirus Rustamov, Executive Assistant to the Head of Mission and Trade and Cultural Affairs Officer. During this productive meeting, our members highlighted the organization's core objectives, emphasizing our efforts to raise awareness of the technology sector among women and girls and to celebrate women's achievements, particularly through initiatives like rural #StarTech programs and the Azerbaijan Women in Tech Awards (AWITA). COLLABORATION OPPORTUNITIES

On July 9, 2024, within the framework of the Business Forum on Women's Participation in the Digital Economy organized by the Azerbaijan Rural Women's Association (AKQA), considering the common interest in the development of information technologies in agriculture, education, and industry, and the need for exchange of ideas, and experience aimed at women's development and gender equality awareness, a Memorandum of Understanding was signed between Femmes Digitales and AKQA. The participants of the MoU were **Safiya Aghamirova**, **Aysel Abdullayeva**, **Gunel Safaraliyeva**, **Ulduza Khalilova** and chairwoman of AKQA - **Gulbaniz Ganbarova**.







On September 30, 2024, Femmes Digitales and STEP IT Academy, represented by Acting Executive Director Nazli Mammadova, and Jana Krimpe, Sayyara Huseynova, Maryam Abbaszade, discussed new collaboration opportunities. The meeting focused on expanding regional programs and AWITA 2024, set to host over 500 attendees. With STEP IT Academy's 9-year involvement in mentoring over 1,000 girls in coding and robotics, both organizations reaffirmed their commitment to advancing gender inclusion in tech.



On October 31, 2024, Femmes Digitales hosted a constructive dialogue with TAG International, focusing on the evolving cybersecurity landscape in Azerbaijan. Jana Krimpe and Sayyara Huseynova held an engaging meeting with key representatives from TAG International, including Jim McKee (Director, National Security & Resilience), Peter Smith (Principal Cyber Security Specialist), and Mariam Kintsurashvili (Strategic Consultant). Participants exchanged insights on the cybersecurity ecosystem, sharing experiences and exploring opportunities for collaboration. A key topic of the discussion was the significant role women play in cybersecurity and the urgent need to promote gender diversity in this vital sector.


